Chambéry Savoie Mont Blanc airport is operated by VINCI Airports on behalf of the Council of Savoie.

Ideally located between lake and mountains, it is the best gateway to the major ski resorts of the French Alps.

In 2016, more than 210,000 passengers flew to the airport by the dedicated business aviation terminal, its 12 scheduled European flights and its ski charter flights operated by 20 tour-operators.

A complete refurbishment of the terminal has been made in 2016 to improve customers satisfaction.
